

This is the first of what will be a series of periodic production updates on the progress of the feature-length documentary film <u>Pandora's</u> <u>Promise</u>.

We are happy to report that after an 18 month effort (interrupted by the events at Fukushima) we have finally finally achieved our funding goal of raising the nearly \$1.2 million required to fully realize the film. A big shout out to everyone whose generosity and courage has made this possible!

We are currently in the process of editing the film.

Additional filming will continue as needed, as will the development of graphics and effects sequences, music production, archival research, and all of the many elements needed to complete the production.

Our goal is to have the film ready to enter it for a world premiere at the Sundance Film Festival in January.

To complement the roll out of the film, we are involved in creating a new pro-nuclear grassroots environmental organization. With initial backing of \$500,000 we hope to announce the launch of this effort this summer. The organization will both support and be supported by the release of the film, while establishing a lasting entity to promote advanced technological solutions to our energy and environmental problems into the future.

In addition, we are pleased to announce that the celebrated British environmental author Mark Lynas will be taking the lead in authoring a companion book to the film in collaboration with Michael Shellenberger and Ted Nordhaus of The Breakthrough Institute.
